Section 5310 Grant Program

- Discussion: Options considered by the STFAC included 1) reducing all requests by an equal percentage to conform to funding availability; 2) allocating funds based on annual number of riders within the service area; 3) allocating funds based on annual number of rides provided within the service area; and 4) prioritizing community connector routes above vehicle purchase and preventive maintenance. Final recommendation proposes a variation of #4 above with community connector routes fully funded, preventive maintenance requests funded at a reduced level, and vehicle request not funded (see attached matrix).

Special Transportation Fund Grant Program

- Discussion: Options considered by the STFAC included 1) reducing all requests by an equal percentage to conform to funding availability; 2) allocating funds based on annual number of rides provided within Deschutes County only; 3) fully funding OFCO and Abilitree and funding CET at a reduced amount; 4) fully funding CET request only to maximize service availability and leveraging of funding. Final recommendation proposes funding CET request at approximately 85%, OFCO at 80%, and Abilitree at approximately 54% to reflect additional 5310 funding recommendation (see attached matrix).
