Summary

Voters approved formation of La Pine Park & Recreation District to provide the community with park, recreation, and cultural enrichment experiences. The District's tax base, approved in 2009, is 30 cents per \$1,000 assessed value. The proposed levy of 27 cents would supplement the tax base for a period of 5 years, commencing in November, 2021.

Levy funds would:

- Support and expand current youth programs for children from kindergarten to high school with adequate supplies, materials and personnel.
- Expand health, wellness, fitness, and active outdoor programs for adults.
- Address deferred maintenance of District owned properties, allowing them to stay available to the community.
- Fund necessary upgrades in technology/media, and service.
- Provide security systems.

A home with an assessed value (not market value) of \$200,000 would pay \$54.00 per year (or \$4.50 per month).
