Final Ballot Title The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the county's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

In November 2020, Ballot Measure 109 was passed by the electors of Oregon. Ballot Measure 109 was approved by 52.8% of the electors in Deschutes County. The Measure created a statewide program to allow licensed providers to administer psilocybin-producing mushroom and fungi products to individuals 21 years of age or older.

Measure 109 (codified as ORS 475A.718) allows the governing body of Deschutes County to adopt an ordinance to be referred to the electors to determine whether the statewide program will be allowed to operate within the unincorporated areas (outside of city limits) of Deschutes County.

A "yes" vote will prohibit the establishment and operation of Psilocybin Product Manufacturing and Psilocybin Service Centers within the unincorporated areas (outside of city limits) of Deschutes County.

A "no" vote will allow establishment and operation of Psilocybin Product Manufacturing and Psilocybin Service Centers within the unincorporated areas (outside of city limits) of Deschutes County.
